The program will feature oral presentations from the top 4 selected abstracts and a poster viewing period where members can vote on the best posters. That plus dinner!

#### All successful applicants will be expected to attend the live event and present their posters in person.

As in the past several years, we shall accept abstracts relevant to rheumatic disease in the following categories: **basic science research**, **clinical research**, **and clinical**. A judging panel will choose the most outstanding 4 **research** abstracts to be given as podium presentations, as well as a monetary award of \$250 each for the podium presenters.

All applicants not selected for podium presentation will be asked to create a poster to be showcased at the forum. During the poster viewing time, members present will be provided score sheets to judge the posters for awards to be handed out later that evening. As in the past, a monetary award of \$100 will be given to the top 4 posters.

8:00-9:00: Podium Presentations and Awards
